Research Analysis

HJR1029 is a constitutional amendment authorizing the 10 school districts with the highest number of students qualifying for free and reduced lunch to issue a 5 mill levy to bring in extra revenue to meet the high economic needs of the district.

Fiscal Analysis

The resolution provides for an economically disadvantaged ad valorem levy in an amount not to exceed five (5) mills for school districts. The levy is authorized only for the ten (10) school districts in the state which have the highest number of students enrolled who qualify for free or reduced lunches as certified by the State Board of Education.

Voter approval is required by the voters of a qualifying district. Revenue resulting from an approved levy will depend on the district valuation and the mills levied.
