**Research Analysis**

HJR 1037 proposes an amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution, to be voted on by the people. The amendment removes the requirement that the income threshold used to determine the homestead exemption for individuals who are at least 65 years old not exceed the median income estimated by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
