**Fiscal Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to the measure directs the expenditure of FY-2022 appropriations to the Department of Public Safety on certain purposes as follows:

- \$439,120 for any necessary expenditures related to interoperable communications inside the State Capitol Building.
- \$4,000,000 to hold a trooper academy. Subject to available funding, the measure authorizes the Department to hold additional academies.
- The measure authorizes the Department to utilize the Department of Public Safety Restricted Revolving Fund (245) as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department by law.
