The engrossed version of SB 1110 directs the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to study methods of conducting remote inspections of meat and poultry products. If the department finds suitable technology, it is to apply for approval with the appropriate federal agency, and if approved, promulgate rules for implementation. Remote inspections are for intrastate commerce only, unless the federal agency approves it for interstate commerce.
