## **Research Analysis**

SB 1203 creates Courtney's Law. The measure requires any health care facility, health care provider, or genetic counselor who renders prenatal care, postnatal care, or genetic counseling upon receipt of a positive test result for a chromosomal disorder, will provide the expectant or new parent with information provided by the State Department of Health for the specific disorder. The measure provides the requirements the State Department of Health must have available on its website. The measure also specifies that such information will, to the extent practicable, be culturally and linguistically appropriate for women receiving a positive prenatal diagnosis or for the family of a child receiving a postnatal diagnosis of a chromosomal disorder.
