Research Analysis

SB 1223 provides that any person who is not an individual with a disability or is not trained to assist individuals with disabilities, who uses a service animal in an attempt to gain treatment or benefits as an individual with a disability is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up to \$500. The measure allows signage to be placed at any public accommodation stating that it is a crime to misrepresent an animal as a service animal.
