**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB1307 requires schools that issue ID cards for students in grades 7-12 to print the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline phone number on the ID cards, and allows schools to also print the Crisis Text line on the ID cards.

The measure further declares it the legislature's intent that public and private colleges and universities print the phone numbers for the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline, the Crisis Text Line, and the campus police on student ID cards.
