Fiscal Analysis

This measure grants to the Health Care Workforce Development Revolving Fund Fifty-Five Million, One Hundred Eighty-One Thousand, Four Hundred Fifty-Eight (\$55,181,458.00) from the Statewide Recovery Fund. The breakdown is as follows:

- \$10,000,000.00 to Southwestern Oklahoma State University;
- \$1,780,000.00 to Murray State College;
- \$634,850.00 to Moore Norman Technology Center;
- \$9,769,689.00 to Oklahoma City Community College;
- \$8,849,223.00 to Tulsa Community College;
- \$9,464,710.00 to Rose State College;
- \$4,537,500.00 to Care Providers Oklahoma;
- \$6,585,487.00 to Southeastern Oklahoma State University;
- \$110,000.00 to Cameron University;
- \$300,000.00 to Carl Albert State College;
- \$300,000.00 to Connors State College;
- \$300,000.00 to Eastern Oklahoma State College;
- \$300,000.00 to Langston University;
- \$300,000.00 to Northeastern Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College;
- \$150,000.00 to Northeastern State University;
- \$300,000.00 to Northern Oklahoma College;
- \$300,000.00 to Northwestern Oklahoma State University;
- \$300,000.00 to Redlands Community College;
- \$300,000.00 to Rogers State University;
- \$300,000.00 to Seminole State College; and
- \$300,000.00 to Western Oklahoma State College.

These grants are to be used for the nursing program purposes of discussed and approved by the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding in it's March 10 and March 31, 2022 meetings.
