## **Research Analysis**

SB 1515 provides that a certified emergency medical response agency may provide limited transport after receiving the approval of appropriate medical control at the time of transport. Emergency transportation shall not be required if a patient's apparent clinical condition does not warrant emergency ambulance transport. Non-transport protocols as the relate to patients must be authorized by the regional medical director.
