Research Analysis

The engrossed version of SB 1524 changes the way interest is charged on the proceeds of oil and gas sales that are not timely paid, and also changes the way proceeds are processed when the party permitting the proceeds sends a division order to the owner of the oil and gas.

The measure requires that proceeds not paid on time will not accrue interest if the proceeds are subject to certain conditions.

The measure also requires any party remitting production proceeds to receive a signed division or transfer order from each owner if the party remitting proceeds has sent a division order to the owner. The signed division order must contain certain information laid out in the measure.
