**Research Analysis**

SB229 allows the State Board of Education to renew, for up to 5 years, the emergency or provisional certificate of an individual who meets certain criteria and maintains a district evaluation rating of “effective”. Teachers with an emergency or provisional certificate may be placed on a temporary contract beyond the four semester limit.

The measure also provides that the Teacher Due Process Act of 1990 does not apply to teachers with emergency or provisional certificates.
