## **Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB 394 exempts an automobile with an equity allowance of not more than \$10,000 from the determination of resources to meet the needs for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) eligibility. Current statute exempts automobiles with an equity allowance of not more than \$5,000. Additionally, the measure changes language to acknowledge from the Commission for Human Services to the Director of Human Services as it relates to rule promulgation.
