**Research Analysis**

SB 429 provides that the Chief Information Officer is to be hired by the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) rather than appointed by the Governor. The measure also removes the requirement that the Chief Information Officer serve as Secretary of Information Technology and Telecommunications or successor cabinet position. The measure deletes the salary range and language regarding eligibility requirements. The measure also modifies the assessment the Chief Information Officer is required to complete annually to no longer include certain recommendations, cost benefit analyses and calculation of net savings. Lastly, the measure modifies certain duties of the Director of OMES.
