Research Analysis

SB 445 provides cumulative penalties for medical marijuana business licensees that make unauthorized sales and for intentional and impermissible diversion of medical marijuana by a patient or caregiver. The measure also specifies that fines paid upon violation of these laws are administrative fines.

Modifications Contained in Floor Substitute

The floor substitute for SB 445 adds penalties for intentional diversion by a patient or caregiver and penalties for intentional diversion by a patient, caregiver, or medical marijuana business or its employee to a minor. The substitute also provides that nothing in the measure shall be construed to prevent the criminal prosecution of a patient, caregiver, or medical marijuana business or it employee who has diverted medical marijuana products to a person with the intent or knowledge that that person intended to engage in trafficking of the products.
