Engrossed SB 45 adds a fingerprint-based national criminal history record check to the Department of Human Services background check requirements. The Department of Human Services may directly request a national criminal history record check from the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation.

Fiscal Analysis

From the Oklahoma Department of Human Services: Because this authority is a permissive rather than mandatory, there is an immediate \$0 impact. Should the Director decide to exercise this authority on all new hires, there could be a potential increase in fingerprinting of approximately 1,100 employees. The cost would be at the admin Rate of 57.82%. Annual cost is estimated between \$0 and \$58,000 (state dollars \$33,000) based on the \$52.25 cost to DHS. This a request bill from DHS.
