**Research Analysis**

SB 503 requires the social studies subject matter standards to include:

- The Declaration of Independence;
- The United States Constitution, including the Bill of Rights;
- Substantive selections from the Federalist Papers;
- The Emancipation Proclamation;
- The Articles of Confederation;
- The Gettysburg Address;
- George Washington’s Farewell Address.

The measure also requires the U.S. History assessment to include multiple questions containing fundamental principles from these historic articles.
