SB 531 exempts retail implement dealers from the requirement to have an escort vehicle when traveling on a roadway with an implement in excess of 12 feet in width.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure modifies the requirements for pilot cars for oversized loads to exclude loads carrying retail implement equipment. The measure does not remove the requirement for an oversized weight permit and the Department of Public Safety does not provide escorts for these oversized loads.
