The CS to SB 9 creates the Sergeant Craig Johnson Act. The measure modifies the definition of accessories by providing that a person may be accountable for accessory to murder if the person knew or reasonably should have known that the conduct committed upon the victim could foreseeably result in the death of the victim.
