**Research Analysis**

The second floor amendment to SB615 requires the superintendent of a school district to provide advanced written notice to a parent about any instruction about sexual orientation or gender identity, and to inform the parent of their right to inspect any materials related to such instruction. The superintendent must also inform the parent of their right to withhold their child from such instruction. No student shall be required to participate in such instruction.
