Research Analysis

SB 631 creates the Second Amendment Sanctuary State Act. The measure occupies and preempts the entire field of legislation by any agency of this state, or any political subdivision in this state to infringe upon the rights of a citizen of the State of Oklahoma the unalienable right to keep and bear arms. Any federal, state, county or municipal act, law, executive order, administrative order, court order, rule, policy or regulation ordering the buy-back, confiscation or surrender of firearms, firearm accessories or ammunition from law-abiding citizens of this state shall be considered an infringement on the rights of citizens. The preemption shall include the provisions of the National Firearms Act of 1934 and the Gun Control Act of 1968.
