**Research Analysis**

The Conference Committee Substitute to SB 644 allows municipalities to authorize all or certain municipal employees to carry concealed firearms by ordinance. The measure provides that carrying a firearm is not to be considered a requirement for continued employment with the municipality. The employees must possess a valid handgun license and must keep the firearm secure at their own expense.. The municipal employee is immune from civil and criminal liability for any injury caused by the firearm if acting in a reasonable and prudent manner. The municipality is not liable for any loss, damage or injuries resulting from any act, failure to act or refusal to act committed by a municipal employee. The measure also clarifies definitions used in the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act.
