SB 646 allows an employee of an establishment that sells alcoholic beverages to carry or possess a weapon while in the scope and course of employment if the employee has permission from the owner. The measure includes liquor stores in the list of business entities that may control the possession of weapons on any property owned or controlled by the business entity.
