## **Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB 647 creates Lily's Law and provides definitions of fetal death and stillbirth. Additionally, the measure subjects birthing centers and medical facilities to the requirements to maintain a written policy for the disposition of the remains of a child from a stillbirth or fetal death event, notify the parents of their right to direct the disposition and that a disposition may be made if no direction is given by a parent within 14 days of delivery. Nothing in the statute prohibits additional notification and assistance to a parent. Current statute only includes licensed hospitals in this language.
