## **Research Analysis**

SB 672 clarifies that a person who is member or veteran of the United States Armed Forces, Reserves or National Guard or was discharged under honorable conditions from the United States Armed Forces, Reserves, or National Guard between the ages of 18 to 21 to transport a firearm on a public highway in his or her vehicle. The measure also clarifies that any person between the ages of 18 to 20 may transport an unloaded firearm on a public highway in or on his or her vehicle.
