**Research Analysis**

FA1 to SB 688 provides that the owner or operator of a social media website who contracts with users in this state is subject to a private right of action by a social media website user if the social media website purposely deletes or censors a social media website user's political or religious speech or uses an algorithm to suppress political or religious speech.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The first floor amendment to the measure is a floor substitute. The amendment would create a right to private action for users of a social media service if their political or religious speech is censored by the social media service. The measure would allow the Attorney General to bring a civil action on behalf of social media service users in Oklahoma.

Upon review, no direct fiscal impact to the state is anticipated from passage of the measure. The measure contains permissive language and would not affect state revenues or expenditures.
