Research Analysis

SB 696 authorizes licensed pharmacists to compound one or more nonsterile preparations for office use by a licensed practitioner. This applies to preparations containing either prescription or nonprescription ingredients, or both. The measure also authorizes a licensed pharmacist to compound one or more nonsterile preparations consisting only of nonprescription ingredients for over-the-counter use by customers. The measure restricts the amount to be kept in stock for over-the-counter preparations. It allows for two weeks' worth of orders.

The measure authorizes a licensed pharmacist to dispense or ship one or more nonsterile preparations for over-the-counter use to a customer under certain conditions. The measure prohibits a pharmacist from shipping any preparations for over-the-counter use to out of state recipients. The measure restricts the amount of volume of any one preparation which may be shipped to a customer outside of a fifty-mile radius of the pharmacy to no more than 10% of volume. The measure applies to any pharmacist licensed by the State Board of Pharmacy located in the state of Oklahoma.
