The Committee Substitute to SB 730 prohibits any person or entity from establishing a policy barring any person or employee, except a convicted felon from transporting, carrying or storing firearms or ammunition in a locked motor vehicle on any property set aside for any motor vehicle or a motor vehicle owned, leased or rented by the person or employee to conduct business for the business entity.
