SB 732 clarifies that the state preemption on the regulation of firearms includes firearm and ammunition components and allows those persons aggrieved by a municipality, political subdivision of the state, or ordinance that violates the state preemption are entitled to reasonable expenses if the court rules in favor of the plaintiff.
