Research Analysis

FA1 to SB 732 adds a new paragraph E. to authorize sheriffs to arrest any person who violates the State Preemption relating to firearms, including any federal employee, contractor, agent or law enforcement officer. The measure creates a felony, punishable by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than one year and one day, a fine of up to \$30,000 or both fine and imprisonment.

Fiscal Analysis

The first floor amendment to the measure adds a section that provides county sheriffs with the authority to implement the provisions of the measure.

The first floor amendment creates a felony for violation of the provisions of the measure. The first floor amendment alters the fiscal impact of the measure by potentially increasing incarceration costs. The ultimate impact of the measure would depend on the disposition of cases.
