FA2 to SB 732 adds a new paragraph E. providing that any person convicted of violating the State Preemption regarding firearms is guilty of a felony, punishable by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than one year and one day, a fine of not more than \$30,000, or both fine and imprisonment.

Fiscal Analysis

The second floor amendment inserts a new subsection to the measure that creates a felony for violations of the provisions of the measure.

By creating a felony, the second floor amendment alters the fiscal impact of the measure. The second floor amendment could potentially increase incarceration costs borne by the state. The ultimate impact of the measure would depend on the disposition of cases.
