**Research Analysis**

SB 942 requires applicants for a restricted commercial driver license to have held a valid driver license for at least 1 year. Applicants with more than two years of driving experience must have a good driving record for the most recent 2 years. Applicants for the restricted commercial driver license are exempt from the knowledge and skills test. Application of the restricted commercial driver license does not have to be used in consecutive days and use of the permit is to be declared at application. The measure defines "good driving record".

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure, as engrossed, would modify the qualifications for the issuance of a restricted commercial driver license by the Department of Public Safety to drivers employed in specific farm-related service industries.

Upon review, no direct fiscal impact to the state is anticipated from passage of the measure. The modification to existing processes for restricted commercial driver license issuance does not create a need for additional appropriations.
