Research Analysis

SJR 23 calls for an Article V Constitutional Convention in order to pass a Constitutional Amendment to limit federal appropriations made by the Congress in a fiscal year to the amount of all estimated federal revenues for that fiscal year.

The joint resolution also calls for a second Article V Constitutional Convention to propose and consider amendments that impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal government, and limit the terms of office for its officials and for members of Congress.
