Bill Analysis

HB 1007 provides that there shall be a rebuttable presumption that a statement appearing on a social media posting or other electronic communication attributed to a person testifying is the statement of that individual. The presumption may be rebutted by a credible denial under oath. The measure also expands “harassment” as it relates to the Domestic Abuse Reporting Act to include social media postings or other electronic communications that includes abusive and threatening messages, impersonating another person, posting sensitive or embarrassing information without consent of the person, and the creation of fake accounts to acquire private information with the intent to threaten or cause humiliation to a person.
