Bill Analysis

HB 1076 prohibits any person under the age of 18 from undergoing gender reassignment medical treatment. Any health care professional found to have violated this prohibition shall be subject to professional discipline by the applicable health care professional health care licensing board. Gender reassignment medical treatment shall include interventions to suppress the development of endogenous secondary sex characteristics, interventions to align the patient's appearance or physical body with the patient's gender identity, and interventions to alleviate symptoms of clinically significant distress resulting from gender dysphoria. It shall not include behavioral health care services, such as mental health counseling or medications to treat depression, anxiety or similar disorders; provided, the medication does not have long-term altering effects on the gender of a minor.
