**Bill Analysis**

HB 1647 provides that any entity offering pretrial services in a county shall be subject to the provisions of the Pretrial Services Act. The measure requires that a victim must be notified and allowed to appear at any proceeding concerning the release of the person from custody. A pretrial services program must obtain background information from the defendant. The program must use court records available through the Oklahoma State Courts Network, Department of Corrections, Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigations, and any other information provider as ordered by the court. The measure requires a pretrial program to file monthly reports and adds additional information which must be collected.
