**Bill Analysis**

HB 1934 provides that any provision in a design professional services agreement which requires an entity or its insurer to indemnify or otherwise hold harmless another entity against liability arising from death or bodily injury, or damage to property, due to negligence or fault of the entity or its agents is void and unenforceable.
