**Bill Analysis**

HB 2122 creates the Oklahoma Cocktails To Go Act of 2021. The measure allows establishments holding a caterer's or a mixed beverage license to sell single-serve wine and cocktails to-go as long as they are in a sealed tamper-proof container. The sealed container must be properly labeled as outlined in the measure. Deliveries must be made by employees of the establishment and must be at least 21 years of age. The employee must be able to verify the age of the customer as well. If delivered or picked up, the beverage must be placed in the trunk of the vehicle, or in the rear compartment of the vehicle if there is no trunk. Third-party deliveries of cocktails are prohibited. Entities holding a license to manufacture alcoholic liquors or beverages are prohibited from being able to sell cocktails to-go.
