## **Bill Analysis**

HB 2335 prohibits any state agency from using any rule, order, or other means to impose a vaccination requirement on the general public or any employee or prospective employee of the state agency. The measure shall apply without exception to any vaccine authorized for emergency use by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA). The measure exempts certain entities from the prohibition on imposing vaccination requirements if the vaccine was approved by the FDA without the use of an emergency use order. The measure exempts child care facilities and state agencies as well as any public charter, private or parochial school, the governing body of a public charter, private or parochial school district, a school district board of education, institutions with the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, and any technology center school from any damages arising from an employee refusing to take a vaccination.
