Bill Analysis

HB 2663 modifies the deadline for absentee ballot requests. The measure extends the period from the Tuesday preceding an election to the third Monday preceding an election. Such requests must be submitted to the appropriate election official. Additionally, the measure modifies the period a person may request an in-person absentee ballot for county elections as well as General, Primary, Runoff Primary Election, or Presidential Preferential Primary Elections. For county elections, the deadline for such requests remains 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on the Thursday and Friday immediately preceding the county election. For Primary, Runoff Primary Election, or Presidential Preferential Primary Elections, the measure provides that ballot requests may be made on the Saturday preceding the election from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. General Election absentee ballots may be requested starting on the Wednesday immediately preceding the election from 8 a.m. To 6 p.m.
