**Bill Analysis**

HB 2805 strikes the requirement that livestock owned by a general partnership, limited partnership, corporation, limited liability corporation, estate, trust, or other lawfully recognized entity must have the primary purpose of conferring economic benefits of such ownership on 2 or more members of the same family in order to qualify for an ad valorem tax exemption.

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
