**Bill Analysis**

HB 3144 prohibits any governmental entity entering into a contract with a company for the purchase of goods or services unless the contract contains a written verification from the company that it does not have a practice, policy, guidance, or directive that discriminates against a firearm entity or firearm trade association and will not discriminate during the term of the contract against a firearm entity or firearm trade association. The measure also clarifies that discrimination against a firearm entity or firearm trade association shall not include the policies of a merchant, retail seller, or platform that restrict or prohibit the listing or selling of ammunition, firearms, or firearm accessories. The provisions of this measure shall apply to companies with 10 or more employees that has a value of \$100,000.00 that is paid wholly or partly from public funds of the governmental entity.
