Bill Analysis

HB 3415 modifies the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act by requiring any public body to stream public meetings on its website provided it has immediate access to a high-speed Internet connection. Videos of the meetings must be maintained by the public body and available to the public until minutes are made available for inspection by the public. The measure also updates language relating to authorization of public bodies to conduct meetings via videoconference by striking language relating to COVID-19 and replacing it with broader language referring to declared emergencies in a county.
