Bill Analysis

SB 1019 creates a \$10,000.00 fine for each instance of a social media company removing or censoring a post when such action is not required by law. Any entity that has a business facility or subsidiary in this state and receives any tax break, subsidy, exemption, or incentive shall be ineligible to receive such benefits for any year in which they have engaged in censorship activities. The measure apportions the revenue in the following manner:

- 1) 50% to the General Revenue Fund,
- 2) 25% to the aggrieved party, and
- 3) 25% to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund
