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**Bill Analysis**

The CS for SB 1021 creates the Hydrogen Production, Transportation and Infrastructure Task Force. The Task Force shall be comprised of 16 members and shall disband on December 31, 2021. The measure requires the Task Force to meet at least once per month and to investigate the viability of utilizing existing pipeline infrastructure to move hydrogen gas, the tax treatment of hydrogen gas, and a state-wide roadmap for a hydrogen economy. The Task Force shall be subject to the provisions of the Open Records Act and its members shall receive no compensation or travel reimbursement. The Task Force shall submit a report of its findings to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and Speaker of the House no later than December 1, 2021.

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
