**Bill Analysis**

SB 1102 provides that subject matter standards for social studies must include at least 45 minutes of instruction on “Victims of Communism Day” on or around November 7<sup>th</sup> of each year. Such instruction shall include various Communist revolutions as well as the aftermath of such revolutions including the suppression of speech, poverty, starvation, migration, and systemic lethal violence used against civilians.
