**Bill Analysis**

SB 1148 clarifies that an individual may openly or concealed carry a firearm on public property designated as parking space by federal, state, or municipal governments as well as public property adjacent to gambling establishments or adjacent to a building that prohibits concealed and open carry. The measure also adds streets, plazas, sidewalks, and alleys to the list of locations a person may carry a firearm. Additionally, the measure provides that a person may openly carry a firearm on property owned by a nonprofit or public trust with permission from the public trust or nonprofit entity.
