Bill Analysis

SB 1181 provides that any board, director, or elected official who has authority to enforce Oklahoma statutes and is discovered to have failed to enforce said statutes shall be held liable for damages incurred and shall have their employment or appointment terminated. The measure authorizes the Attorney General to investigate allegations of failure to enforce state statutes. Additionally, such entities that fail to enforce state statutes shall be criminally liable and shall be sentenced as determined by the court.
