Bill Analysis

The FS for SB 1223 provides that any person who is not an individual with a disability or is not trained to assist individuals with disabilities shall be guilty of a misdemeanor if said person attempts to use a service animal in an attempt to gain treatment or benefits as an individual with a disability. The FS caps the fine for such a conviction at \$500.00 and allows any public accommodation to post signage stating that it is a crime under state law to misrepresent an animal as a service animal.
