Bill Analysis

SB 1225 provides that no person, corporation, association, organization, state-supported institution, or individual employed by any of these entities may administer a vaccine to a minor without the parent or guardian's consent. Additionally, no minor may self-consent to obtain contraception or family planning counseling except for those who are unmarried, have a dependent child, are emancipated, or are separated from and unsupported by their parents or guardian.
