Bill Analysis

SB 1294 provides that it shall be unlawful for any person to allow a child to possess a firearm for a purpose other than participation in hunting animals, hunter safety classes, education and training in the safe use and handling of firearms, and other sporting events. A child is defined by the measure as a person under the age of 19 enrolled in a high school or a high school equivalency program. The act of allowing a child to possess a firearm is defined as selling or giving a child a firearm or the act of a firearm owner intentionally or negligently leaving a firearm unsecured and accessible for a child to take, obtain, or possess.
